Non-Infectious Waste



Non infectious clinical waste is commonly known as offensive waste. Although not harmful to human health, non-infectious waste needs to be disposed of with care.

Non-infectious waste is waste contaminated with bodily fluids from patients with no known or suspected infection, such as swabs, dressings, nappies or incontinence wastes. Non-infectious waste bags are disposed of via deep landfill.

Instructions for use:

Place non-infectious waste contaminated with bodily fluids from patients with no known or suspected infection in this Tiger striped bag. Waste includes blood contaminated waste, swabs and wound dressings.

Health and Safety Precautions: Use this waste bag as per the instructions, ensuring the bag is not filled more than two thirds full.
